Artist Statement: My name is Jacquie Kennerson, a self-taught, almost 60-year-old disabled artist. Painting was my beginning - I didn't pick up a brush until about twelve years ago. Then a serious car accident changed my hands and my path. After three surgeries to repair my wrist, I lost a significant amount of feeling in my hand and fingers, and with it the control needed to paint. But creativity doesn't disappear...it simply finds a new road. Today, I create through **photography, digital photo art, sun catchers, and candle-making** - different forms, same heart. I often use **reused canvases** and **secondhand frames** on purpose. I love the idea that every piece carries a past - a little history, a quiet mystery, a secret story of its own. So if you notice small imperfections, please know: they aren't flaws here. They're part of the journey - a part of what makes each piece **truly one of a kind**.
